Community Foundation's 2014 Grants Benefit Local Organizations 2015 Grant Cycle Information Announced

January 26, 2015 – The Lancaster County Community Foundation of South Carolina awarded grants totaling \$4,500 to five nonprofit organizations in 2014. The organizations included:

\$750 to Children's Council for the Reach Out & Read Program.
\$1,000 to Christian Services, Inc. – SC for the Food for Families Program.
\$1,000 to Lynnwood United Methodist Church for the Bridge Food Program.
\$1,000 to Hope In Lancaster, Inc. to purchase fresh and healthy food for their clients.
\$750 to Lancaster County Council of the Arts for their Summer Smarts arts & sciences camps.

The 2015 grant cycle will open May 18th and the deadline to apply is noon on June 19th. Funding interests will be announced closer to the cycle opening. The grant cycle will be conducted through a newly enhanced online application process. Informational webinars are scheduled for February 4th and March 4th at 3:00.
