Grants Available for Stanly County Nonprofits Stanly County Community Foundation Now Accepting Applications

February 26, 2018 - The Stanly County Community Foundation is currently accepting applications from eligible Stanly County 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations, congregations, governmental and educational institutions for its 2018 grant cycle.

In 2017, the Stanly County Community Foundation awarded over \$50,000 in grant funding to local organizations. The grants ranged in size from \$1,500 to \$5,000. **With additional funding available in 2018, the board will also consider awards up to \$10,000 for the most compelling and competitive applications.** Proposals for larger grant awards are encouraged to identify additional funding sources and partnerships with other organizations.

Grants will be awarded to benefit a broad range of charitable purposes; however, the Foundation is primarily interested in education, human service, and arts and culture initiatives. Additional information and guidance is available online.

Completed applications must be submitted by noon on Friday, March 23, 2018. The grant application system closes promptly at 12:00 p.m. and will not accept late submissions.
