

TARGETED PREVENTION

Targeted Population: Families who face homelessness and are deemed likely to have a path toward financial stability within 3 months*

Rental Stipend: Up to 3 months to stabilize the household

Support Services: Short-term case management, landlord negotiation, life skills, money management, referrals to community providers and other resources to help empower families to return to financial stability

Primary Outcome to Be Tracked: Maintain independent housing stability in 6 months and 12 months after exiting program

AWH HOUSING

Targeted Population: Homeless families earning less than 50% of Area Median Income*

Rental Subsidy: Short-term (up to 2 years) in scattered apartments. Maximum subsidy: \$500 per month per family; \$700 per month in certain high-income zip codes

Support Services: Case management and range of other services that may include clinical social work, connections to interventions (addiction treatment, mental health support, vocational training, financial literacy, parenting, etc.) and a family support network

Primary Outcome to Be Tracked: Status of housing and financial independence 12 and 24 months after exiting program; other outcomes to be developed and tracked
