Bulow Bowman Awards Scholarships to Two Lincoln County High School Students

LINCOLNTON – The Bulow Bowman Scholarship Fund has announced its 2019 undergraduate scholarship awards.

She was a teacher of 4-H TRY-IT, as well as a mathematics mentor and tutor.
- **Tanner Buff**, daughter of Skye and Teddy Buff of Lincolnton, is a graduate of North Lincoln High School. She will attend NC State University under the exploratory studies program. Buff has been a representative of the Student Government Association, a participant for Habitat for Humanity Community Builds and played junior varsity volleyball. She has been a member of the Beta Club, National Honor Society and the National Technical Honor Society.
