



## Charlotte Mecklenburg Community Foundation now accepting applications for its Social Capital Grants cycle

The Charlotte Mecklenburg Community Foundation – the grantmaking arm of Foundation For The Carolinas – recently opened its Social Capital Grants cycle. Applications will be accepted from eligible 501(c)3 nonprofit organizations until Friday, Nov. 1, at noon.

The Social Capital Grants program aligns with the <u>recommendations</u> of the Leading on Opportunity report. It is designed to support organizations and programs focused on building social capital networks, relationships and access to opportunities – through the lens of increasing economic opportunity for all children, youth and families within Charlotte-Mecklenburg.

The program will concentrate on supporting and strengthening organizations and programs that build and nurture social capital within and among communities and organizations. The program should promote a culture of caring and life navigation:

Maximum or minimum grant sizes have not been determined, however it is likely that grants awarded will range from \$2,500 - \$10,000. Larger amounts will be considered for exceptional proposals.
