

Our mission is to provide each youth living in Charlotte's public and subsidized housing an opportunity and expectation of obtaining a post-secondary education. We believe that having financial access to a post-secondary education, combined with emotional support and social capital — will assist our scholars create viable paths to self- sufficiency.

We fight poverty by giving students access to education. The students we serve — those under the age of 25 who live in INLIVIAN-managed residents and have a desire to attend college or a technical/vocational school — are among the most vulnerable in our community. While Greater Steps Scholars is not part of INLIVIAN, we partner to identify and recruit eligible students.

In addition to offering up to five years of scholarships to our Scholars, our program also considers the entire picture of what a student needs to succeed, including one-on-one coaching and mentorship, workshops that teach valuable career, financial, and life skills, as well as exposure to potential internship and career opportunities.
